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Dear Parents / Carers of Year 2 children

As part of the National Curriculum, children in all classes follow a scheme of work in both Sex and Relationships Education (SRE) and Drugs Education (DE). In partnership with other schools, we have adopted the Christopher Winter Project (CWP), which is a resource to support with the delivery of these lessons.

This work forms part of the statutory Science curriculum and Personal, Social and Health Education programmes recommended by the National Curriculum and the Local Authority.

These lessons will be taught by the class teacher, this half-term. In the SRE lessons children will be learning about **Differences: boys and girls; male & female and naming the body parts**. The correct terminology will be used for body parts eg penis and vagina. In the DE lessons children will be learning about **Keeping Safe: risk, hazardous substances and safety rules**.

The lessons will provide an opportunity for your child to raise questions and we encourage your child to discuss the content of the lessons with parents.
