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Dear Parents / Carers of Year 6 children

As part of the National Curriculum, children in all classes follow a scheme of work in both Sex and Relationships Education (SRE) and Drugs Education (DE). In partnership with other schools, we have adopted the Christopher Winter Project (CWP), which is a resource to support with the delivery of these lessons.

This work forms part of the statutory Science curriculum and Personal, Social and Health Education programmes recommended by the National Curriculum and the Local Authority.

These lessons will be taught by the class teacher week beginning 2 June and 9 June 2014. In the SRE lessons children will be learning about **Puberty and Reproduction: puberty changes (including menstruation), relationships and reproduction, conception and pregnancy**. In addition to these lessons, the girls will receive a talk about menstruation by the school nurse. In the DE lessons children will be learning about **Legal and Illegal Drugs: preventing early use; Cannabis; volatile substance abuse; getting help, advice and support**.

The lessons will provide an opportunity for your child to raise questions and we encourage your child to discuss the content of the lessons with parents.
