PARENTS' SAFER PARKING CHARTER

The Junior Safety Officers and School Council at Woodfall Primary School have created and designed their very own Safer Parking Charter. They want everyone who drives to Woodfall Primary to sign up to the following Parking Charter to help keep everyone safe and improve the quality of life for all those within the school environment. Please remember Road Safety is everyone's responsibility.

I hereby agree to abide by the guidelines outlined by the children within the Safe Parking Charter. By signing up to this charter you agree to:

- Driveways – Please don't park in front of neighbours' houses due to them having to get in and out of their houses.
- Double Parking – Please don't double park because it may cause traffic to build up around school grounds. People may back up and cause crashes and damage your car. It may also cause blockages.
- Staff Car Park – Please do not park in the staff car park or walk through. Staff need to get in – it's also dangerous walking through.
- Park Away – Please park at the Royal Oak and walk if possible because young children will be able to park closer to school so they are safer.
- Lines - Please don't park on the Zig-Zags, T bars or double yellow lines because it could cause double parking or you could get a fine.

If at all possible Walk to School







WHAT THE LINES AND SIGNS MEAN

Waiting restrictions apply to the whole of the highway including pavements and verges




Double yellow lines along the edge of the road mean no waiting at any time. You can stop to load or unload or to allow passengers to get in or out of the vehicle unless there are also loading restrictions.



Single Yellow Lines along the edge of the road mean you cannot wait during the times shown on the signs. You can stop to load or unload or to allow passengers to get into or out of the vehicle unless there are also loading restrictions.




Limited waiting
Parking is permitted at the times and for the duration shown on the signs, once you have left the parking area you cannot return to park in the same area within the "No return" duration. Outside these times you can park for any duration.



Parking is not permitted on the footway or verge



Taxis only are allowed to stop. No other vehicle is allowed to stop, load or unload within the bay during the times stated on the signs.





No parking or loading at any time on the verge or footway




Buses only are allowed to stop. No other vehicle is allowed to stop, load or unload within the bay during the times stated on the signs.

School keep clear markings
No vehicle is allowed to stop, load or unload during the times shown on the signs.

Entrance to a restricted parking zone where both waiting and loading are prohibited during the times shown in the lower panel.
