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Dear Parent/Carer

As you are aware, we have planned a meeting for all parents who are interested in learning more about our approach to teaching Sex and Relationships Education (SRE) and Drugs Education for **Thursday 27 November 2014 at 6.00pm in the infant hall.**

As part of the National Curriculum, children in all classes follow a scheme of work in Sex and Relationships Education. In partnership with other schools, we use the Christopher Winter Project (CWP) which is a resource to help with the delivery of these lessons.

This work forms part of the Science and Personal, Social and Health Education programmes recommended by the National Curriculum and the Local Authority. The Christopher Winter Project has been working successfully with schools since 1995. CWP has produced a successful scheme of work with lessons that have a clear structure and are age appropriate.

Each class will eventually receive a series of lessons taught by the class teacher. In addition, some lessons will be led by teachers from the CWP project. Aspects of SRE will still be covered by the school nurse in some year groups during the course of the academic year.

We look forward to seeing as many parents as possible at this meeting.
