To continue the success of Wake Up, Shake Up we will be having a whole school Zumba at 9.20am in the Junior Playground if the weather is kind to us so please feel free to come and join us. This will give the children a healthy start to the day and a chance to warm up ready for the day of competition ahead.

Infants

Parents are invited to support our **Infant Sports Morning** which will start at 9.50am on the field.

The morning will be split in two parts:

Part 1

- Your child will be in a team made up of Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 children and take part in a round robin of activities.

Part 2

- The children will take part in a series of races competing against children from their own year group.
- There will also be a parents/ carers race so bring your trainers and lots of cheers!

Juniors

- Junior children will take part in a series of individual athletic events during the morning within their classes.
- Parents are invited to support our **Junior Sports Afternoon** which will run from 1.15 – 3.00pm (approx) to be followed by a short presentation for the winning team.
- We would be grateful if any parents and children could carry a chair or item of equipment back to the hall on their way from the field as this saves a lot of tidying up at the end of a tiring day for the children!
- Parents (and grandparents) will be invited to take part in our traditional parents' races so please come prepared with your running shoes!

General Information

- All children must wear their school PE t-shirt (team colours for Juniors), shorts and trainers. Infants and Junior children will bring these home on Wednesday 3rd June 2015 and should arrive in school wearing their PE kit. Please send your child, both Infants and Juniors, into school with their school jumper to wear throughout the rest of the day. Please ensure that your child has a filled water bottle, cap (and suncream – weather dependent) for the event.
- To make sure the day progresses smoothly and to prevent accidents, it is essential that parents do not encourage their children to run across the tracks to see them or that parents do not cross the tracks themselves. Also please do not allow younger children to cross to see their older brothers and sisters.
- Parents and relatives of pupils should note that any photographs or video film they take at school events are likely to contain images of other children who may not have given permission to be filmed or photographed. Such images should not be circulated more widely than the family; i.e. they should be for the family's use only and **not** uploaded onto social network sites such as Facebook.
- We are hoping the weather will be kind to us on the day; however, please check the message board on Woodfall's website www.woodfall.cheshire.sch.uk or listen to event details on 0151 338 2288 for up to date information on the day, should bad weather cause cancellation. Should the event have to be postponed this decision will be made purely in the interests of the children's safety.
