# \*\*Outstanding Payments\*\*

Please can you ensure that all of the children's accounts for Lunch, Nursery, Before and After School Club, Trips and Music are settled promptly and are kept up to date. There are a large number of payments outstanding which need to be addressed as a matter of urgency. If you are having difficulties making payments, please don't hesitate to speak to a member of staff in the office and we will eandeavour to support you.

#### Emergency Contacts

Whilst more serious accidents are few and far between, I would like to inform you that in order to contact you quickly, as per our School Policy, we will work through the contact numbers in the order specified on your data collection sheet. #### Safeguarding

The school has a legal duty to report any non-accidental injuries to children. Where children have had an injury from an accident outside school, we ask that parents please inform the school so that we respond appropriately. The school's Child Protection and Safeguarding Policy will involve links with police and/or social care as appropriate. It is therefore essential that parents inform the school of accidental injury to pupils whilst they are at home. The school cannot hesitate to report any instance of suspected abuse. Thank you for your help with this.

#### **Holidays During Term Time**

Cheshire West and Chester Council have recommenced Fixed Penalty Notices. Please can we remind parents that all absences must be put in writing and handed into the office. May we also remind parents that the Headteacher is not able to authorise holidays during term time.

#### PE Kits / Swimwear

Please can you ensure that children bring their PE Kits into school on a Monday. These need to stay in school during the week in the event that a PE session is changed at short notice. Swimwear must be a full swimsuit or trunks. No bikinis or Bermuda shorts please.

# Mobile Phones - Children & Parents

All children bringing mobile phones into school need to immediately hand in their mobile phones into their teachers. These phones must not be used on our school premises. Parents / Carers, please refrain from using your devices on school premises where possible. Thank you.
