### Parking / Car Parks

Please be reminded that idling engines whilst parked affects the air quality for your children, families and residents.



**The law states that is an offence to idle your engine unnecessarily when stationary.**

Sadly, in spite of our recent efforts setting up a parking charter, we are still seeing children being dropped off on the yellow lines in a 'stop and drop' manner.

Please pull into an appropriate space to allow your child to disembark and cross safely. It will only cost you a few extra seconds and could well prevent any unnecessary incidents.



Anyone currently accessing disabled parking bays in either of our car parks, please bear in mind these are predominantly for staff and whilst we are, of course, happy to allow access to the disabled bays for those who need them, may we ask that you park sensibly.

**Remember, the school run can be a very stressful time for all, so please be patient with each other, both on the road and in parking areas. Anyone reported to be abusive to staff and other users in the car park will no longer be invited to park there.**

### Recurring Messages

#### **\*\*Outstanding Payments\*\***

Please can you ensure that all of the children's accounts for Lunch, Nursery, Before and After School Club, Trips and Music are settled promptly and are kept up to date. There are a large number of payments outstanding which need to be addressed as a matter of urgency. If you are having difficulties making payments, please don't hesitate to speak to a member of staff in the office and we will endeavour to support you.

#### **Emergency Contacts**

If you change any contact phone numbers, please let the office know. Whilst more serious accidents are few and far between, I would like to inform you that in order to contact you quickly, as per our School Policy, we will work through the contact numbers in the order specified on your data collection sheet. You may find it useful to add us to your mobile phone contacts 0151 832 5020 for caller display purposes.

#### **Safeguarding**

The school has a legal duty to report any non-accidental injuries to children. Where children have had an injury from an accident outside school, we ask that parents please inform the school so that we respond appropriately. The school's Child Protection and Safeguarding Policy will involve links with police and/or social care as appropriate. It is therefore essential that parents inform the school of accidental injury to pupils whilst they are at home. The school cannot hesitate to report any instance of suspected abuse. Thank you for your help with this.

#### **Holidays During Term Time**

Cheshire West and Chester Council have recommended Fixed Penalty Notices. Please can we remind parents that all absences must be put in writing and handed into the office. May we also remind parents that the Headteacher is not able to authorise holidays during term time.

#### **PE Kits / Swimwear**

Please can you ensure that children bring their PE Kits into school on a Monday. These need to stay in school during the week in the event that a PE session is changed at short notice. Swimwear must be a full swimsuit or trunks. No bikinis or Bermuda shorts please.

#### **Mobile Phones - Children & Parents**

All children bringing mobile phones into school need to immediately hand in their mobile phones into their teachers. These phones must not be used on our school premises. Parents / Carers, please refrain from using your devices on school premises where possible. Thank you.

#### **Queries and Concerns**

Should you have any concerns or queries regarding any aspect of the school day, please do contact us directly. It is not helpful for parents to contact and report an issue to another parent based solely on what their child has informed them without first seeking clarity from school. Thank you.
